Class 56 - Chocolate Beetroot Cake

300 gm caster sugar	250gm cooked, well drained and pureed beetroot
250 mls vegetable oil	3 eggs
½ tsp vanilla extract	225 gm plain flour
¼ tsp salt	5 rounded tbsp cocoa powder
	1 ½ tsp bicarbonate of soda

1. Grease 23 cm x 32 cm tin (approx.) or 23 cm spring form round cake tin.
2. Oven Gas Mark 4 or 180 C
3. In a large bowl, combine pureed beetroot, sugar, oil and vanilla until well mixed.
4. Sieve together flour, cocoa, salt and bicarbonate of soda.
5. Add to the creamed mixture, beating well together.
6. Pour into tin and bake for 30 – 45 mins, depending on the depth of the tin.
7. The cake should feel firm in the centre.
8. Cool and then frost with favourite icing – beetroot juice gives a nice pink colour.
