Recipe for Class 56

Orange Zest Loaf Cake

200g Caster sugar	125 ml milk
225g Self Raising flour	2 eggs
pinch of salt	½ tsp vanilla essence
125g butter or margarine at room temp	grated zest of 1 large orange
Orange icing: 15 g butter	juice of the orange
180g icing sugar	

Set oven to 190C (170C fan oven) or gas mark 5. Line a 1kg loaf tin (22 cm x 15 cm).

Place all ingredients, for the cake, in a large mixing bowl. Using an electric mixer, beat for 1 minute on low speed. Turn speed to medium and beat for another couple of minutes until sugar is dissolved and mixture is smooth, light and fluffy.

Pour mixture into the lined loaf tin and bake for 40 mins until light and golden Turn onto a wire rack and allow to cool.

To make the icing, put the butter and orange juice in a pan over a medium heat and stir until the butter is melted. Add the icing sugar and stir till it forms a smooth consistency.
