Recipe for Class 56 (thanks go to Cherry Jones)

Golden Apricot and Marzipan Loaf Cake

150gms SR Flour **75gms butter** **50gms caster sugar**

50gms of chopped soft dried apricots **75gms sultanas**

75mls milk **a few drops of almond essence** **1 egg**

75gms marzipan

To finish

1 tablespoon apricot jam **1/2 tablespoon boiling water** **1 tablespoon flaked almonds**

450gm /1lb loaf tin

- 1) Oven Gas 4/ 180 C
- 2) Grease and line the base of tin or use liner.
- 3) Sieve flour into bowl and rub in the butter until the mixture looks like fine crumbs.
- 4) Stir in the sugar.
- 5) Add apricots and sultanas and mix well.
- 6) Whisk the egg, add the milk and essence.
- 7) Stir into the dry ingredients to make a soft batter.
- 8) Spoon half of the mixture into the tin and spread evenly.
- 9) Cut the marzipan into 1.5cm cubes and arrange on top of cake mixture.
- 10) Spread the remaining cake mixture on top evenly to fill the tin.
- 11) Gently bang the tin on work surface to get rid of any pockets of air.
- 12) Bake for 50-60 minutes until firm. Test with a skewer, avoiding marzipan.
- 13) Transfer the tin on to wire rack and leave to cool for 15 minutes before turning out and cooling completely on wire rack.
- 14) Gently warm the jam with the water to make a sticky glaze to brush over the top of the cake and scatter the flaked almonds on top.
